COUNSELING

This year I ask parents/guardians to reach out to myself or their child's homeroom teacher if they would like their child to be referred to one-on-one counseling and/or psychoeducational small groups. This is important for all **returning and new students**. **Including students that have previously accessed counseling services**. This process ensures a holistic approach to supporting your child's mental health and well-being.
