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Enhanced Programing Opportunities

Did you know we are offering **S.T.E.M** as an Elective to all of our Grades 5, 6, 7, and 8 students!? **Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (S.T.E.M)** course uses engineering principles and trade skills to design hands on projects.
