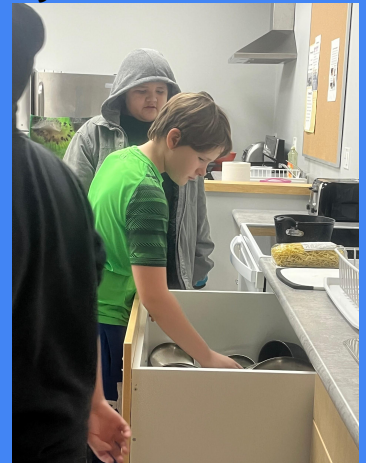

Quality Teaching– Literacy

In this LA project for Grade 6's, students researched and planned a "fake trip" to a country of their choice. They explored the country's culture, landmarks, food, language, and history, creating a detailed itinerary and explanation of trip details that reflected its unique characteristics. Students then presented their trips to the class through posters, slideshows, and written stories, sharing the highlights of what they learned. This project helped develop research, writing, and presentation skills while encouraging cultural exploration. The students got to end the big project by creating a dish from their country of travel. Many delicious dishes were created. The students cooked foods from China, Japan, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Argentina, Fiji and Costa Rica.
